135 Chapter I: The Student Union, its members and purpose

136 1 Section The status and purpose of the Student Union

137 The name of the Student Union is the Student Union of the University of Turku, abbreviated TYY. The
138 registered office of the Student Union is in Turku.

139 The purpose of the Student Union is to serve as a link among its members and to promote their
140 societal, social and intellectual aims as well as those related to studying and to the societal status of
141 students.

142 2 Section Members

143 All university students admitted to studies leading to lower or upper university degree are part of the
144 Student Union. The Student Union may also admit other university students as its members.

145 In the elections and member votes of the Student Union, a member of the Student Union registered as
146 present has the right to vote.

147 In the elections and member votes of the Student Union, all eligible for voting have an equal right to
148 vote. An eligible person to stand as a candidate for a member of the Student Union Council and the
149 Executive Board is each with the right to vote, unless otherwise provided in these Rules or in the
150 Election rules.

151 3 Section Honorary member

152 The Student Union may invite a person for whom it wishes to show respect as an honorary member.
153 An honorary member is invited in a meeting of the Student Union Council, when at least two thirds of
154 the members of the Student Union support it. The Student Union shall keep a record of its honorary
155 members.

156 4 Section Quorum and administration

157 The supreme power of decision in Student Union affairs shall be exercised by the Student Union
158 Council elected through proportional elections. For the preparation and implementation of issues, the
159 Student Union Council shall appoint an Executive Board which exercises decision-making,
160 administrative and executive authority as well as a Financial Board which exercises decision-making,
161 administrative and executive authority in the affairs set by these rules.

162 5 Section Disqualification

163 Elected official of the Student Union may not vote or make decision proposals when making decisions
164 on a financial agreement relationship between that elected official and the Student Union, or whether
165 the private financial interest of that elected official might contradict with the interest of the Student
166 Union.

167 When deciding on filling a position of trust, the elected official shall not be disqualified merely on this
168 basis to participate in the decision-making.

169 The Administrative rule provides more specific provisions on the disqualification of the members of
170 the Executive Board.



171 Chapter II: Student Union Council

172 6 Section Student Union Council elections

173 The Student Union Council is elected among the members of the Student Union with a general vote.
174 More specific provisions on the Student Union Council elections are provided in the Election rules
175 approved by the Student Union Council.

176 The Student Union Council appoints a Central Election Committee as provided in the Election rules, the
177 task of which is to organise Student Union Council elections.

178 7 Section Members and term

179 The Student Union Council includes forty-one (41) eligible members of the Student Union.

180 Members of the Executive Board of the Student Union, employees with a valid contract and people in
181 senior positions in Student Union companies shall be disqualified to serve as members in the Student
182 Union Council.

183 The term of office of the Student Union Council begins on 1 January and lasts for two (2) calendar
184 years.

185 8 Section Deputy members

186 If a member of the Student Union Council loses their eligibility for elections or is biased or otherwise
187 prevented from attending a meeting, a deputy member shall substitute the member as specified in the
188 Election Rules and in the Administrative Rules.

189 9 Section Chairs of the Student Union Council (Chairs of the Student Union)

190 The Chair and the Vice-Chair have a right to speak and a right of attendance in all the organs of the
191 Student Union. The Chair represents the Student Union in its annual celebration.

192 The Chair and the Vice-Chair of the Student Union Council are elected among the regular members of
193 the Student Union Council for a calendar year.

194 The Chair of the Student Union Council does not have a right to vote in the meetings of the Student
195 Union Council.

196 When the Vice-Chair of the Student Union Council serves as the Chair of the meeting, what is provided
197 in these Rules and in the Administrative rules about the Chair of the Student Union Council is applied
198 to the Vice-Chair, and a deputy member will be invited to the meeting to replace the Vice-Chair as
199 provided in the Administrative rules.

200 If the Chair and the Vice-Chair of the Student Union Council are both permanently prevented, the
201 meeting of the Student Union Council may elect a temporary Chair among its members, who shall
202 serve as the Chair until the Student Union Council has in the same meeting elected a Chair or a Vice-
203 Chair who can chair the meeting. The temporary Chair has the right to vote when serving as the Chair
204 in the issues mentioned in paragraphs 1–6 of Section 25(1) of the Administrative rules and when
205 electing the Chair of the Student Union Council.



206 10 Section Student Union Council group

207 An official Student Union Council group shall be established by noting it in a written form in a meeting
208 of the Student Union Council. The notice shall include the name of the Student Union Council group,
209 the members and deputy members, the Chair and a necessary number of Vice-Chairs, members of the
210 Election Committee and a necessary number of deputy members and the contact details of the Student
211 Union Council group. A member or a deputy member of a Student Union cannot belong to more than
212 one official Student Union Council group.

213 An official Student Union Council group may

214 1) draft proposals for the Student Union Council,

215 2) provide statements for the Executive Board upon request,

216 3) draft proposals for the Executive Board.

217 The official Student Union Council groups are entitled to access the material based on the decision-
218 making, which is also available for the committees of the Student Union Council and the Executive
219 Board.

220 11 Section Tasks of the Student Union Council

221 Student Union Council

222 1) elects a Chair and Vice-Chair among its members;

223 2) elects the Executive Board of the Student Union and its Chair;

224 3) elects the Election Committee and its Chair;

225 4) elects the Financial Board of the Student Union and its Chair;

226 5) elects the Executive Committee of Turku Student Newspaper and its Chair;

227 6) upon the proposal of the Election Committee, elects student representatives in the University
228 Collegiate Council of the University of Turku and elects representatives of the Student Union to the
229 Union meeting of the National Union of University Students in Finland and in the Delegation of Turku
230 Student Village Foundation and Union Meetings of Student's Sports Federation;

231 7) elects the auditors of the Student Union;

232 8) upon the proposal of the Election Committee, decides on the appointment of the Secretary General
233 and upon the proposal of Turku Student Newspaper, decides on the employment of the Editor-in-Chief
234 of Turku Student Newspaper;

235 9) shall annually approve the plan of action and once a term the political agenda;

236 10) based on the proposal of the Executive Board, shall approve the budgets and supplementary
237 budgets of the Student Union, of its independent functional units, and of the properties, and order the
238 membership fee of the Student Union to be confirmed by the Rector of the University of Turku.



- 239 11) shall decide on the approval of the financial statements of the Student Union, of its independent
240 functional units and of the properties as well as on the formal approval of actions for the Executive
241 Board and other accountable people;
- 242 12) shall discuss the annual report provided by the Executive Board on the activities of the Student
243 Union, of its independent units and of the properties and decides on the consequential actions;
- 244 13) based on the proposal of the Financial Board, shall discuss the issues which concern property
245 purchase, selling, exchange or renting, or conducting an exchange of land, mortgaging, engaging in new
246 building or assigning shares of a housing co-operative owned by the Student Union. The same applies
247 for taking a loan for new building;
- 248 14) approves the Rules, Administrative Rules, Election Rules and other Management- Regulations of
249 the Student Union;
- 250 15) invites an honorary member upon the proposal of the Executive Board and decides on other marks
251 of honour, unless otherwise provided in these Rules;
- 252 16) shall decide on the expenses compensation to the meetings of the Student Union Council and the
253 subordinate organs; and
- 254 17) decides on other issues that the Student Union Council reserves in the manner provided in the
255 Rules or that the Executive Board deems necessary to be decided by the Student Union Council.
- 256 12 Section Student Union Council meetings
- 257 The Student Union Council shall convene when deemed necessary by the Chair or if at least ten (10)
258 members of the Student Union Council so request from the Chairs in a written form for the discussion
259 of a stated matter, or as prescribed in the Rules. The Student Union Council shall convene in a
260 celebration meeting annually on the anniversary of the Student Union Council, 9 Nov.
- 261 The Chair of the Student Union Council may convene the Student Union Council in one or several
262 premises or if needed, with only IT tools, i.e. as a remote meeting.
- 263 Invitation to a meeting of the Student Union Council shall be delivered electronically or, if so
264 requested, in a written form for all members of the Student Union Council, and the meeting shall be
265 announced at the official bulletin board of the Student Union at least seven (7) days before the
266 meeting.
- 267 Before the start of its term of office, between November 20th and December 10th, the Student Union
268 Council shall convene in an organising meeting, where the Executive Board and the Chairs of the
269 Committees, as well as the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Student Union Council and the Financial Board
270 for the next term are elected. The Student Union Council shall decide in its organisational meeting the
271 regular meeting time of the council.
- 272 Viimeistään huhtikuun kokouksessa päätetään 11 §:n 11 ja 12 kohdissa mainituista asioista.
- 273 The Student Union Council constitutes a quorum when at least twenty-one (21) members and the
274 Chair or the Vice-Chair are present.



275 13 Section Decision-making and voting

276 Unless otherwise provided in the Rules or Administrative Rules, the Student Union Council makes
277 decisions with an absolute majority. Empty votes are not counted as votes cast. If the votes result in a
278 tie, a draw shall resolve the vote.

279 In appointing persons, either majority election or proportional representation is adhered to.

280 14 Section Right to speak and right of attendance.

281 Every member of the Student Union and everyone performing tasks of the Student Union shall have
282 the right to attend the meetings of the Student Union Council. The Chair of the Student Union Council,
283 members of the Executive Board of the Student Union, the Chair of the Financial Board, employees of
284 the Student Union, the Chairs of committees, boards and wings, and the people separately decided in
285 the meeting shall have the right to speak.

286 15 Section Right of initiative of the members

287 The Student Union Council shall discuss all matters addressed to it by the members and organisations
288 of the Student Union. In the discussion, the representative of the initiative shall have a right to speak in
289 the meeting of the Student Union Council.

290 16 Section Consultative referendum

291 If the wide-ranging or significant nature of a matter so require, the Student Union Council may subject
292 a single issue to a consultative referendum. At the same time, the Student Union Council decides on the
293 realisation of the referendum.

294 17 Section Reserving the right to decide

295 The Student Union Council may reserve the decision-making power included in the authority of the
296 Student Union for its discussion. The Chair of the Student Union Council or ten (10) members of the
297 Student Union Council are entitled to demand in a written form a matter to be reserved for the Student
298 Union Council, after which the matter shall be discussed in the following meeting of the Student Union
299 Council. The reservation shall be made in a week from the decision of the organ. However, the Student
300 Union Council cannot make decisions based on its right to reserve that mean changing the legally
301 binding decisions of the Student Union.

Chapter III: Board

304 18 Section Members and term

305 Student Union Executive Board includes Chair and five to seven (5–7) Executive Board members, who
306 shall all be eligible members of the Student Union.

307 The term of the Executive Board begins on 1 January. If the Executive Board is elected at another time
308 in the middle of the term of the Executive Board, the term of the new Executive Board shall begin
309 immediately after being elected by the Student Union Council. In such case, the Executive Board
310 elected shall have the authority in the matters of the Student Union.

311 The term of office of the Executive Board shall end at the end of a calendar year, in case the Executive
312 Board requests a resignation or in case it receives a vote of no confidence. This also applies for an
313 individual member of the Executive Board.

314 The Chair and Vice-Chair of the Student Union, a member of the Student Union Council and an
315 employee of the Student Union may not serve as members of the Executive Board.

316 19 Section Executive Board election method

317 The Chair of the Student Union Council shall serve as the person responsible for inviting the
318 preliminary talks for the Executive Board, as specified in the Administrative Rules.

319 The election of the Executive Board considers the gender parity rule of the Equality Act. Upon request,
320 the gender of a trans or non-binary person can be defined as the one that the person feels closest to,
321 even if different from the legal gender. In such case, the gender can also be considered other than male
322 or female. The person should inform the matter to the Chair of the Student Union Council.

323 The Chair of the Executive Board shall be elected first. Before the election of the members, the Student
324 Union Council decides on the number of members.

325 In case of no unanimity, the election of the members of the Executive Board shall be held with closed
326 ballot as provided in the Administrative Rules.

327 If an Executive Board member loses their eligibility for elections or has to resign from the Executive
328 Board for any other reason, the Student Union Council may elect a new member to replace them by
329 absolute majority. The Chair of the Student Union Council, and the Vice-Chair if they are prevented,
330 shall ensure in such case that the above-mentioned equitable proportion rule is realised.

331 The Executive Board shall elect a Vice-Chair among its members for the term and agree on the internal
332 distribution of tasks.

333 20 Section Tasks of the Executive Board

334 The task of the Executive Board is to exercise administrative and executive authority of the Student
335 Union, and especially:

336 1) to exercise the right to speak of the Student Union, make agreements that have more economic or
337 other significance than minor ones and other legal acts on behalf of the Student Union, unless
338 otherwise provided by the law and these Rules, the Administrative Rules and the Regulations, and
339 represent the Student Union in other matters;



- 340 2) to manage the execution of the decisions of the Student Union Council, unless the execution is
341 prescribed to another body;
- 342 3) to control the administration and financial administration of the Student Union;
- 343 4) to prepare the issues brought up in the meetings of the Student Union Council, except elections
344 mentioned in Section 11:2, unless the preparation belongs to another organ on the basis of the Rules
345 or a decision of the Student Union Council;
- 346 5) to approve the plan of action, political agenda, budget and financial statement to be presented for
347 the Student Union Council;
- 348 6) to decide on the employment at the Student Union, excluding the Secretary General and the Editor-
349 in-Chief of Turku Student Newspaper, unless otherwise stipulated in the Rules;
- 350 7) to elect, upon the proposal of the Election Committee, the student representatives in the Board of
351 the University, Faculty Councils and the Board of the School of Economics and in the Degree Board and
352 the Financial Aid Board of the University of Turku;
- 353 8) to elect the representatives of the Student Union and make the proposals in the organs of the
354 Finnish Student Health Services;
- 355 9) to elect the representatives of the Student Union in the Board of Directors of the Student Village
356 Foundation of Turku;
- 357 10) to elect the members of the Film Board for the following term. The Film Board elects a Chair
358 among its members;
- 359 11) to process the resignation of a student representative in the University Collegiate Council;
- 360 12) to elect members in the Wings of the Student Union;
- 361 13) to manage the contact with the student organisations and other communities, with which it is
362 necessary for the Student Union to have cooperation;
- 363 14) to manage the communication activities of the Student Union;
- 364 15) to provide the Student Union Council with an annual report on the activities of the Student Union;
- 365 16) to decide on the expenses compensation to the meetings of the Executive Board and the
366 subordinate organs;
- 367 17) to manage, discuss and decide other matters not prescribed in these rules or otherwise under the
368 authority of the Student Union Council or of another body of the Student Union.
- 369 The Executive Board shall refer a matter under its authority which is important in principle and wide-
370 ranging with regard to the activities of the Student Union to the Student Union Council. If such issue
371 cannot be referred to the Student Union Council due to its urgency, the Executive Board shall
372 communicate to the Student Union Council immediately before the decision-making.
- 373 If the Student Union Council deems necessary, it may transfer a discussed matter under preparation of
374 the Executive Board before making the decision.



375 21 Section Quorum and invitation

376 The Executive Board constitutes a quorum when at least half of the members of the Executive Board
377 and the Chair or the Vice-Chair is present and when the meeting has been invited in accordance with
378 the Administrative Rules of the Student Union.

379 The Executive Board also convenes without a separate invitation in the meeting of the Student Union
380 Council.

381 22 Section Organisational meeting

382 The Chair of the new Executive Board invites the elected Executive Board before the start of the term to
383 an organisational meeting, in which the Chair of the Executive Board serves as the Chair.

384 In the organisational meeting, the Executive Board elects among its members a Vice-Chair, decides on
385 the division of labour between the members and on the regular meeting times of the Executive Board
386 and orders the meeting sanction system.

387



388 Chapter IV: Committees

389 23 Section Appointment of committees

390 The Student Union Council or the Executive Board may, based on their consideration, to set
391 committees for the duration of their term or for a shorter period.

392 Upon appointing the committee, the Student Union Council or the Executive Board shall decide its
393 tasks, composition and term.

394 The Student Union Council appoints the Financial Board and the Election Committee for the duration
395 of its term.

396 For other applicable parts, the provisions of these Rules and the Administrative Rules shall be applied
397 in the operation of the committees.

398 24 Section The tasks of the Committee

399 The task of the committees is to prepare such matters discussed in the Student Union Council or
400 Executive Board meeting that require profound deliberation or special expertise due to their nature.

401 Upon its discretion, the committee can also discuss proposals in its operational field that are directly
402 made for the committee by a Student Union organisation, Student Union Council group or a single
403 member of the Student Union Council or the Executive Board.

404 25 Section Election Committee

405 The Student Union Council sets an Election Committee for the period of its term and appoints its Chair
406 among its members. The Election Committee shall elect a Vice-Chair among its members. In
407 accordance with the Administrative regulation, the Election Committee includes representation from
408 all Student Union Council groups.

409 The Election Committee prepares the elections to the University Collegiate Council and the Secretary
410 General for the Student Union Council.

411 The Election Committee shall prepare for the Executive Board the election of the members in the
412 University Board, Academic Appeals Board, Faculty Councils and the Board of the School of Economics,
413 the organs of the Finnish Student Health Service and the Board of Directors of the Student Village
414 Foundation of Turku.

415 In addition, the Election Committee shall discuss other matters ordered by the Student Union Council
416 or the Executive Board.

417 26 Section Financial Board

418 The Student Union Council sets a Financial Board for the period of its term and appoints its Chair.
419 Financial Board includes Chair and six (6) ordinary members among the members of the Student
420 Union. The Financial Board shall elect a Vice-Chair among its members.

421 If necessary, the Financial Board may hear experts.

422 The task of the Financial Board is:



- 423 1) to control the financial activities and bookkeeping of the Student Union;
- 424 2) to prepare the proposal for a budget for the Executive Board;
- 425 3) to discuss the Executive Board proposal for the financial statements of the Student Union and to
426 provide the statements related to that to the Student Union Council;
- 427 4) if needed, to prepare other matters of financial quality processed in the Student Union Council;
- 428 5) to provide a statement to the Executive Board on granting debts and guarantees;
- 429 6) to decide on the execution methods and schedules of the financial-administrative planning based on
430 a proposal by the Executive Board and to follow the progress of financial-administrative planning;
- 431 7) to take special notice on the coordination of the finances of the Student Union and its businesses;
- 432 8) to serve as the general meeting of the companies owned by the Student Union and to appoint the
433 representatives in the general meetings of the companies partly owned by the Student Union;
- 434 9) to ensure sufficient documentation and reporting on its activities to the Student Union Council;
- 435 10) to manage the planning and execution of the training of the following Committee; and
- 436 11) to establish sub-divisions or temporary working groups, if needed.
- 437 While performing its task, the Financial Board is entitled to access information and reports on all the
438 operations of the officials of the Executive Board and the Student Union. On the measures of the
439 business of the companies owned by the Student Union, the Financial Board receives information to
440 the extent it does not cause harm to the said business.

441



442 Chapter V: Representation

443 27 Section Right to representation

444 In matters belonging to the authority of the Student Union Council shall be represented by the Chair or
445 Vice-Chair of the Student Union Council and the Secretary General, always two together.

446 In matters belonging to the authority of the Executive Board, the Student Union is represented by the
447 Chair or Vice-Chair of the Executive Board and the Secretary General, always two together. In financial
448 issues, documents are signed by the Chair or Vice-Chair of the Executive Board and the Secretary
449 General, always two together.

450 In matters belonging to the authority of the Financial Board, it is represented by the Chair or Vice-
451 Chair of the Financial Board and the Secretary General, always two together.

452



453 Chapter VI: Employees of the Student Union

454 28 Section TYY Staff

455 The Student Union has employees in order to manage the administration and tasks.

456 29 Section Representatives of the employer

457 The Chair of the Executive Board or the Vice-Chair and the Secretary General, always two together,
458 represent the employer in matter related to employment.

459 30 Section Superior

460 The superior of the employees of the Student Union is the Secretary General. The Executive Board is
461 the superior of the Secretary General, represented by the Chair of the Executive Board.

462 If an employee is dissatisfied with a solution of their superior, they may request the issue to be
463 discussed by the Executive Board.

464 31 Section Revision of the provisions in the Chapter

465 When changing the provisions of this Chapter, the Student Union Council shall consult the employees
466 of the Student Union.

468 Chapter VII: Finances

469 32 Section Financial period

470 The financial period of the Student Union is a calendar year.

471 33 Section Covering the expenses

472 The expenses resulted from the activities aimed at executing the purpose of the Student Union are paid
473 with the assets of the Student Union, with the income received from the activities and business, and
474 with membership fees.

475 34 Section Budget

476 Annually, the Financial Board together with the Secretary General and the Financial Secretary shall
477 consult the Executive Board and present by the end of October the budget of the Student Union to the
478 Executive Board, foreseeing the fixed and changing expenses for the following financial year. The
479 Executive Board of the Student Union shall present the budget for confirmation of the Student Union
480 Council before the start of the financial term of the budget.

481 If necessary, supplementary budgets can be drafted for the Student Union Council during the financial
482 period.

483 35 Section Membership fee

484 The Student Union Council shall decide on the ordering of fees under Section 33 in connection with the
485 approval of the budget. The other members than the honorary members of the Student Union shall pay
486 the fee each academic year or, for a special reason, each term.

487 The fee shall be ordered in equal amount to each member of the Student Union who is conducting
488 basic degree and is present during the academic year. The membership fees for autumn and spring
489 term can be different.

490 The membership fee of the Student Union shall be decided by the Student Union Council and
491 confirmed by the university Rector. The Executive Board of the Student Union may decide on the
492 exemption from the membership fee in part or in total, if it is evident due to the verified lack of means
493 of a member that the membership fee would risk their right to basic education under Section 16 of the
494 Constitution of Finland.

495 36 Section Financial statement

496 The Executive Board shall prepare a financial statement for each financial year. At the same time, the
497 Executive Board and the accountable people shall provide the auditor with the bookkeeping of the
498 previous year and the related documents, as well as other documents clarifying the administration of
499 the Student Union during the financial year.

500 37 Section Auditor

501 An auditor shall be appointed to control the accounts and administration of each budget year, who
502 shall be an auditor approved by the Central Chamber of Commerce (KHT), and a personal deputy
503 auditor with the same requirements or an audit firm approved by the Central Chamber of Commerce.



- 504 If a KHT audit firm is appointed as the primary auditor, deputy auditor shall not be appointed.”
- 505 38 Section Audit Report
- 506 The auditor shall provide a report on the performed control by 15 March. The report and required
507 reviews required on the basis of its notifications shall be submitted to the Student Union Council by
508 the Executive Board at the latest in the meeting where the financial statement is processed.

- 510 Chapter VIII: Celebrations, honours, symbols, ribbons and badges
- 511 39 Section Anniversary and celebrations
- 512 The Student Union celebrates its anniversary on 9 November for the honour of Henrik Gabriel
513 Porthan.
- 514 The anniversary of the merge of the Student Union of the University of Turku and the Student Union of
515 Turku School of Economics is the signature date of the merger agreement, 18 February.
- 516 40 Section Honours
- 517 As a recognition for the work conducted for the Student Union, the Student Union may grant ribbons of
518 honour and merit as well as different badges and other marks of honour.
- 519 Actions, which may have the character of an honour, joy, sorrow or other representation, are decided
520 by the Executive Board.
- 521 41 Section Symbols
- 522 As its symbols, the Student Union has its own flag, community ribbon, colour plate, wing torch and
523 table standard.
- 524 42 Section Honour Committee
- 525 The Honour Committee of the Student Union decides on the distribution of ribbons and badges. The
526 Student Union Council annually appoints the Chair and five members of the Honour Committee. The
527 person elected in the Honour Committee shall have a ribbon of praise of the Student Union. In
528 addition, the Chair of the Student Union Council serves as a member of the committee. The Secretary
529 General of the Student Union shall serve as the secretary of the Honour committee.
- 530 43 Section Symbol of the Student Union
- 531 The symbol of the Student Union is the wing torch. The name or acronym of the Student Union can also
532 be attached to the symbol.

534 Chapter IX: Changing the rules

535 44 Section Methods

536 The Student Union Council shall decide on changing these rules. Changes can only be made in the
537 provisions of the Rules that have been mentioned in the invitation to the meeting. Section that is not
538 mentioned in the invitation can be discussed by declaring it urgent with a two thirds (2/3) majority.
539 The changing decision shall be made through a majority of two thirds (2/3) in two meetings of the
540 Student Union which shall have at least a period of one week in between. The changing decision shall
541 be valid after the Rector of the University of Turku has confirmed the change.

542 With a unanimous decision, the Student Union Council may deviate from these rules in an individual
543 matter unless otherwise prescribed in these Rules.

Chapter X: Appeal

546 45 Section General right of appeal

547 A person towards whom a decision has been targeted or towards whose right, interest or obligation
548 the decision has a direct impact has the right of appeal of a decision made by the Student Union
549 Council, the Executive Board and the Financial Board on the basis that their private right has been
550 violated, as provided in the Administrative Procedure Act. The appeal shall be made in the
551 administrative court in 30 days from the date on which they have received information on the
552 decision. Decision made for the appeal can be appealed to the Administrative Court as provided in the
553 Administrative Procedure Act. Decision made for the appeal can be appealed to the Administrative
554 Court as provided in the Administrative Procedure Act.

555 Every member of the Student Union has the right of appeal also on the basis that their private right has
556 been violated, and a member of the Student Union also on the basis that the decision has not been
557 made in accordance with law, rules or other regulations concerning the Student Union, or that an
558 organ has exceeded their powers, or that the decision is otherwise contrary to the law, rules or other
559 regulations concerning the Student Union.

560 The appeal shall be made in the administrative court in thirty (30) days from the date in which the
561 decision has been put on display as prescribed by the rules, or if the decision concerns a person
562 privately, in the same period of time from the date on which they have received information on the
563 decision.

564 Appeal cannot concern a decision concerning solely preparation or execution of a matter.

565 46 Section More detailed provisions

566 In addition to these rules, the Administrative Rules and regulations approved by the Student Union
567 Council shall be complied with.
