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Plan of Action 2017

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*This draft describes the influential projects of the Student Union for the following year.
Project descriptions are specified and the internal aims are prioritised
more specifically on the basis of the preliminary debate.*

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10 1. Possibilities for flexible studying

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All-year education: Open university study supply cost-free in the summer
for basic degree students, limits of subsidy months reconsidered
in relation to conducting summer studies

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Digitalisation and internships: Modernisation of learning environments,
Developing university pedagogics and the quality of teaching as part of the digital project
of the Ministry of Education and Culture; increasing interaction between education and
working life by improving internship practices.

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University well-being work: Promotion of studying ability in faculty-specific groups,
Where student representatives are supported; special emphasis on OpintoVartu, i.e.
the model for early support.

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Supporting studying ability: Developing digital services supporting studying ability
(e.g. Opiskelijan Kompassi) together with study psychologists.

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Finnish teaching in international Master's programmes: Harmonisation of practices
from 2018; encouraging for studies and use of language and change of
attitudinal environment e.g. with a communication campaign.

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34 2. TYY of organisations

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Revision of activity support criteria: Process and criteria
more transparent and clear, regulation revised in autumn 2017.

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Council of Chairs: Concept more accessible, motivating and
participatory.

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Guides for organisations: Equality guide, environmental guide, internationalism,
Alcohol-free activities; criteria and instructions for monitoring these in granting support.

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Support of sports activities: Development of OLL cooperation and communication,
Organisations' promotion of sports interests towards CampusSport.

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48 **3. Awareness of the promotion of student interests and services**

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Communication on the promotion of student interests: Practical promotion of student interests more visible, encouraging people to join TYY activities. Service and student interest promotion mapping for different groups, e.g. filial campuses and doctorates.

Network of graduate students: Supporting the establishment of an organisation for graduate students and arrangement of peer support activities.

Communication on structural changes: Systematic and topical communication on changes, e.g. student income; cooperation with SYL and Kela.

60 **4. Students as part of the City and Region**

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Students' joint municipal election campaign in Turku: Activating students to vote and influencing contents; preparation together with Group 40,000.

Municipal election influence in filial campuses: Supporting the organisations in planning, review of a need for actions after elections.

Regional elections 2018: Making connections with the regional administration, active monitoring of regional and social and healthcare reforms, planning the election campaign, FSHS influence.

Accessibility of services for international students: Mapping an assistance network for international students across university borders and compiling an information package in order to find authority, leisure, and career services.

Contact with the business life in Turku: Company visits of international students as part of continuous activities, encouraging organisations for similar activities for all students.

Increasing sports premises: Influence and support in finding short- and long-term premise solutions for CampusSport.
