



Executive Board proposal to the Student Union Council 26 Oct 2016

TYY's three-year plan for 2017–2019

The targets of medium-term influence and aims of the Student Union of the University of Turku (TYY) have been described in this three-year plan. The purpose of the three-year plan is to bring continuity and perseverance in influence and to support the planning of over-year activities. The results of influence are reviewed and impacts are assessed annually upon the revision of the three-year plan. The purpose of the three-year plan is not to be a description of TY Y's continuous activities.
